1. Lexington & Concord Tour

Tues. 8/12/08 (1:00 pm - 4:30pm) \$ 40 PER PERSON

Join us for a drive to the sites where the American Revolution began. Our coach will bring us to Lexington, a quiet farming community in 1775, Our guide will relate the events leading up to the march of the Red Coats from Boston out into the countryside and the story of Paul Revere's ride. At Lexington, we will have time to walk on the Green where the first patriots were killed at dawn on April 18, 1775. Then we will continue to Concord where our militia marched on the Red Coats guarding the North Bridge and fired "the shot heard round the world." The war had begun. There will be some walking, perhaps 100 yards at the North Bridge.
