

Ragnarök, the final battle in Germanic mythology, seemed omnipresent among American intelligence officers. They called it Götterdämmerung or Twilight of the Gods, and quipped that the time had come. Allegedly invincible powers would be toppled, Germany cut in half, and the 1,000-Year Reich crumbled. The victors would form a different balance.

Readers can watch Major General Stanley Eric Reinhart and many of his comrades in arms on their fast-paced trek through Europe, see them end in the center of that continent what the attack on Pearl Harbor had provoked in the Pacific. They can watch troops prepare for combat, celebrate victory, and become caregivers. Readers encounter weapons arsenals, casualties and prisoners of war. They see soldiers stuck in the mud, carcasses frozen to the ground, ruins of bombed cities and civilians desperately trying to hang on. They meet survivors and freed hostages, be they royalty or clergy, and in the end, readers witness what Reinhart concluded in 1945: "In spite of everything, we licked the obstacles."
